***RADARS® System Executive Director to Present
Prescription Opioid Abuse, Misuse and Diversion Data
at the Annual Meeting of the American Society for Addiction Medicine***

Richard C. Dart, M.D., Ph.D., Executive Director of the RADARS System, will travel to Toronto, Canada, to present at the 39th Annual Medical-Scientific Conference of the American Society of Addiction Medicine. On April 10 – 13, 2008.

Dr. Dart will present RADARS System prescription opioid abuse, misuse and diversion data through 2007 as part of a seminar, *Buprenorphine and Office-Based Treatment of Opioid Dependence*, held on Sunday, April 13, 2008. This seminar will address the efficacy and safety of current buprenorphine treatment.

The RADARS System was initially created by Purdue Pharma L.P. in 2001 under the guidance of an external advisory board of medical and scientific experts in substance abuse and law enforcement. In 2006, the Rocky Mountain Poison and Drug Center, a division of Denver Health, acquired the RADARS System.
