




Prescription Drug Abuse in the United States










FIGURE 3. Initial route of abuse versus route of abuse at admission in a substance abuse treatment center.




NEW FORMULA MIXED W/ WATER GELS

Tamper Resistant Strategies

- Hard coatings which resist crushing
- Polymers which turn to viscous gel when heated
- Polymers which resist dissolving in water and alcohol
- Nasal tissue irritants
- Novel delivery systems (patches, implants, etc.)


Number of People Filling a Prescription for OxyContin® or Opana® ER




Poison Center Program Route of Abuse



ORF = OxyContin ADF, CRF = Opana ER ADF Intentional Abuse: An exposure resulting from intentional improper or incorrect use of a substance where the victim was likely attempting to gain a high, euphoric effect or some other psychotropic effect.

Conclusions

- Prescription drug abuse affects all countries
- Hydrocodone and oxycodone are the most prevalent drugs abuse
- Oxymorphone and methadone are most abused when drug supply in considered
