



Epidemic of Drug Mortality - Still Increasing




Most Deaths Involve Multiple Drugs

Estimated prevalence of lifetime Kratom use is 1.3% = 3,353,624 adults





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Kratom Abuse Profile Worse Than Prescription Opioids






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
Mortality of Prescription Stimulants is Rising

population




